It protects the highest peak in northeast Brazil, with a unique montane forest ecosystem combining Atlantic Forest and caatinga elements. Vale do Catimbau National Park is divided between the municipalities of Buíque (17.6%), Ibimirim (40.41%) and Tupanatinga (41.99%) in Pernambuco. The ecoregion forms a series of discontinuous, island-like enclaves amongst the much larger and dry Caatinga xeric shrubland and thorn forests ecoregion. It is part of the 1,885 hectares (4,660 acres) Fazenda Rabeca, and occupies an area of 1,485 hectares (3,670 acres). The ESEC is in the Jaguaribe River basin, which covers just over 51% of the state. As of 2017, *O. maracasana* is considered endangered. It has an area of 12,579 hectares (31,080 acres). The term "biome" has several meanings. Although it includes both the plants and the animals and microorganisms of a community, in practice, it is defined by the climate and physiognomy or general appearance of the plants of the community. The Pico do Jabre rises to 1,197 metres (3,927 ft), and is the highest peak of the six northeast states of Pernambuco, Paraíba, Rio Grande do Norte, Piauí, Ceará and Maranhão. == Location == Species are classified in four groups, set through criteria such as rate of decline, population size, area of geographic distribution, and degree of population and distribution fragmentation. species in the world, Brazil has the greatest biodiversity of any country on the planet. Brazil is also the country with the most native species of edible fruits (over 300).
