

Yellow To White Teeth

Schreber's yellow bat It was first described in 1774 by the German naturalist Johann Christian Daniel von Schreber, who named it *Vespertilio nigrity*. In captivity, the related white-bellied yellow bat (*Scotophilus leucogaster*) has eaten geckos and Schreber's yellow bat (*Scotophilus nigrity*) or the giant house bat, is a species of vesper bat. Its natural habitats are subtropical or tropical moist lowland forests, dry savanna, and moist savanna. It is found in Benin, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Ivory Coast, Ghana, Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique, Nigeria, Senegal, Tanzania, Togo, and Zimbabwe. It is an uncommon species and its biology is poorly known. as suggested by the cusp pattern of the cheek teeth. It was later transferred to the genus *Scotophilus*, making it *Scotophilus nigrity*

Honduran white bat Honduran white bat uses carotenoids to produce the yellow-orange coloration of its ears, nose-leaf, and lips. It was the first mammalian species to be documented

Human tooth At the edges of teeth where there is no dentin underlying the enamel, the rest. The normal color of enamel varies from light yellow to grayish white

Description Hydrogen peroxide (H_2O_2) is the active ingredient most commonly used in whitening products and is delivered as either hydrogen peroxide or carbamide peroxide. Hydrogen peroxide is analogous to carbamide peroxide as it is released when the stable complex is in contact with water. When it diffuses into the tooth, hydrogen peroxide acts as an oxidising agent that breaks down to produce unstable free radicals. In the spaces between the inorganic salts in tooth enamel, these unstable free radicals attach to organic pigment molecules resulting in small, less heavily pigmented components. Reflecting less light, these smaller molecules create a "whitening effect". Peroxyacids are an alternative to hydrogen peroxide and also contribute to the breakdown of pigment molecules. Tooth discoloration tooth. Sometimes there are several different co-existent factors responsible for discoloration. Teeth have a thin enamel layer on the outer surface. External discoloration is accumulation of stains on the tooth surface. Internal discoloration is due to absorption of pigment particles into tooth structure. The enamel layer is whiter and semitransparent, and contributes blue, pink green tints to the Tooth discoloration is abnormal tooth color, hue or translucency fa5ec9fe73

Schreber's yellow bat is a large, robust bat, the largest vesper bat in Africa. It has a head-and-body length of about 190 mm (7 in), a tail length of 80 mm (3 in) and a forearm length of about 80 mm (3.1 in), females tending to have slightly longer forearms than males. The canines are well-developed, the upper jaw has a single incisor and four cheek teeth on each side, and the lower jaws have no incisors and five cheek teeth.
