Side effects of estradiol cypionate include breast tenderness, breast enlargement, nausea, headache, and fluid retention. Estradiol cypionate is an estrogen and hence is an agonist of the estrogen receptor, the biological target of estrogens like estradiol. Estradiol cypionate is an estrogen ester and a long-lasting prodrug of estradiol in the body. Because of this, it is considered to be a natural and bioidentical form of estrogen.

Levonorgestrel The more time that has passed since sex, the less effective the medication becomes. The primary Levonorgestrel is a hormonal medication used in a number of birth control methods. Levonorgestrel works by preventing or delaying ovulation so an egg cannot be released. In an intrauterine device (IUD), such as Mirena among others, it is effective for the long-term prevention of pregnancy. A levonorgestrel-releasing implant is also available in some countries. The dosage used for emergency contraception is ineffective when ovulation has already occurred, and has been found to have no effect on implantation. As an emergency birth control, sold under the brand names Plan B One-Step and Julie, among others, it is useful within 72 hours of unprotected sex. morning-after pill (also known as emergency contraception) multiple times doesn't change its effectiveness, and won't cause any long-term side effects. It is combined with an estrogen to make combination birth control pills. It decreases the chances of pregnancy by 57-93%

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
