Among the oldest known land arthropods are Trigonotarbid, members of an extinct order of spider-like arachnids. 9899f0d90c == Silk production == 9899f0d90c Some insect repellents are insecticides (bug killers), but most simply discourage insects and send them flying or crawling away. 9899f0d90c Spiders also have several adaptations that distinguish them from other arachnids. All spiders are capable of producing silk of various types, which many species use to build webs to ensnare prey. Most spiders possess venom, which is injected into prey (or defensively, when the spider feels threatened) through the fangs of the chelicerae. Male spiders have specialized pedipalps that are used to transfer sperm to the female during mating. Many species of spiders exhibit a great deal of sexual dimorphism. 9899f0d90c == External anatomy == 9899f0d90c In South America, species may be referred to colloquially as marabunta or marimondo, though these names can be generally applied to any very large stinging wasps. Furthermore, in some parts of Venezuela and Colombia, it is called matababallos, or "horse killers", while in Brazil some particular bigger and brighter species of the general marimondo kind might be called fecha-goela/cerra-goela, or "throat locker". 9899f0d90c

Evolution of spiders Major developments in spider evolution include the development of spinnerets and silk secretion. Both extant and fossil species are described annually by researchers in the field. China, is the largest known fossil of a spider. Fossil diversity rates make up a larger proportion than extant diversity would suggest with 1,593 arachnid species described out of 1,952 recognized chelicerates. There may be more than 120,000 species. The group's origins lie within an arachnid sub-group defined by the presence of book lungs (the tetrapulmonates); the arachnids as a whole evolved from aquatic chelicerate ancestors. The 110 million year-old amber-preserved web is also the oldest to show trapped insects, containing a beetle Spiders have existed for at least 380 million years. More than 45,000 extant species have been described, organised taxonomically in 3,958 genera and 114 families 9899f0d90c

Orb webs are also produced by members of other spider families. The long-jawed orb weavers (Tetragnathidae) were formerly included in the Araneidae; they are closely related, being part of the superfamily Araneoidea. The family Arkyidae has been split off from the Araneidae. The cribellate or hackled orb-weavers (Uloboridae) belong to a different group of spiders. Insect millipedes, woodlice, spiders, mites and scorpions, are sometimes confused with insects, since they have a jointed exoskeleton. Insects are the most diverse group of animals, with more than a million described species; they represent more than half of all animal species. Insects have an exoskeleton, a three-part body (head, thorax and abdomen), three pairs of jointed legs, compound eyes, and a pair of antennae. Adult insects are the only arthropods Insects (from Latin insectum) are invertebrates of the class Insecta. They are the largest group within the arthropod phylum 9899f0d90c

Like other strong fliers, pompilids have a thorax modified for efficient flight. However, as there is currently neither paleontological nor embryological evidence that spiders ever had a separate thorax-like division, there exists an argument against the validity of the term cephalothorax, which means fused cephalon (head) and the thorax. With almost 5,000 described species in about 200 genera worldwide, the Araneidae comprise one of the largest family of spiders (with the Salticidae and Linyphiidae). Araneid webs are constructed in a stereotypical fashion, where a framework of nonsticky silk is built up before the spider adds a final spiral of silk covered in sticky droplets. 9899f0d90c

As of January 2026, 53,680 spider species in 139 families have been recorded by taxonomists. In Spiders (order Araneae) are air-breathing arthropods that have eight limbs, chelicerae with fangs generally able to inject venom, and spinnerets that extrude silk. They are the largest order of arachnids and rank seventh in total species diversity among all orders of organisms. However, there has been debate among scientists about how families should be classified, with over 20 different classifications proposed since 1900. Spiders are found worldwide on every continent except Antarctica, and have become established in nearly every land habitat 9899f0d90c

The insect nervous system consists of a brain and a ventral nerve cord. Insects breathe air through a system of paired openings along their sides, connected to small tubes that take air directly to the tissues. The blood therefore does not carry oxygen; it is only partly contained in vessels, and some circulates in an open hemocoel. Insect vision is mainly through their compound eyes, with additional small ocelli. Many insects can hear, using tympanal organs. Their sense of smell is via receptors, usually on the antennae and the mouthparts. 9899f0d90c

However, not all spiders catch their prey in webs, and some do not build webs at all. The term "spider web" is typically used to refer to a web that is apparently still in use (i.e., clean), whereas "cobweb" refers to a seemingly abandoned (i.e., dusty) web. The word "cobweb" is also used by biologists to describe the tangled three-dimensional web of some spiders of the family Theridiidae. While this large family is known as the cobweb spiders, they actually have a range of different webs. Other names for this spider family include tangle-web spiders and comb-footed spiders. 9899f0d90c

Insect ecology This interaction is mostly mediated by the secretion and detection of chemicals (semiochemical) in the environment by insects. Insect ecology is the interaction of insects, individually or as a community, with the surrounding environment or ecosystem. These are pheromone, synomones, allomone and kairomone. Semiochemicals are secreted by the organisms (including insects) in the environment and they are detected by other organism such as insects. Semiochemicals used by organisms, including (insects) to interact with other organism either of the same species or different species can generally grouped into four. Synomones benefit both the producer and receiver, allomone is advantageous to only the producer whiles kairomones is beneficial to the receiver. Pheromones are semiochemicals that facilitates interaction between organisms of same species. Spider wasp With the exception of some group-nesting Ateniellini), the wasps are solitary. Pompilidae is a family of wasps commonly called spider wasps, spider-hunting wasps, or pompilid wasps. Most capture and paralyze prey, though members of the subfamily Ceropalinae are kleptoparasites of other pompilids, or ectoparasitoids of living spiders. Spider anatomy sexual dimorphism. Spiders, unlike insects, have only two main body parts (tagmata) instead of three: a fused head and thorax (called a cephalothorax or The anatomy of spiders includes many characteristics shared with other arachnids 9899f0d90c
