This species measures 30–38 cm (12–15 in) in length excluding the tail, with males growing larger than females. Despite bearing some resemblance to a skunk (of the family Mephitidae), it belongs in a separate family known as the Mustelidae, and genetic analysis suggests that its closest living relative is the African striped weasel. Its fur is mostly black, with distinctive white stripes running down its back and white patches on its face and tail, though the exact patterning is highly variable. the mother gives birth to and raises her litter of two or three young. Breastfeeding Health organizations including the WHO recommend exclusively breastfeeding for six months; this means that no other foods or drinks—other than vitamin D supplement—are typically given. Infants may suckle directly from the breast, or milk may be extracted with a pump and then fed to the infant. Newborns who are Breastfeeding, also known as nursing, is the process whereby breast milk is fed to an infant or toddler. The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends that breastfeeding begin within the first hour of a newborn's birth and continue as the baby wants. assists in the mother–child bonding for both mother and baby, and is thought to encourage instinctual breastfeeding behavior in the infant. Between 2015 and 2020, only about 44% of infants worldwide were exclusively breastfed in the first six months of life. Newborns typically lose 7–10% of their birth weight in the first few days, but they usually regain it within Child development stages are the theoretical milestones of child development, some of which are asserted in nativist theories. Many children reach some or most of these milestones at different times from the norm. There exists a wide variation in terms of what is considered "normal", caused by variations in genetic, cognitive, physical, family, cultural, nutritional, educational, and environmental factors

Holistic development sees the child in the round, as a whole person – physically, emotionally, intellectually, socially, morally, culturally, and spiritually. Learning about child development involves studying patterns of growth and development, from which guidelines for 'normal' development are construed. Developmental norms are sometimes called milestones – they define the recognized development pattern that children are expected to follow. Each child develops uniquely; however, using norms helps in understanding these general patterns of development while recognizing the wide variation between individuals.

Childbirth As attitudes began to change, some Childbirth, also known as labour or delivery, is the completion of pregnancy, where one or more fetuses exits the internal environment of the mother vaginally or via caesarean section and becomes a newborn. Vaginal birth is the most common mode of birth worldwide. It involves three stages of labour: the shortening and opening of the cervix during the first stage, descent and birth of the baby during the second, and the birth of the placenta during the third. During the first stage, contractions gradually become stronger and closer together. The postpartum period is the time of recovery for the mother and infant, in which both newborn and mother are monitored. All major health organisations advise that immediately after giving birth, regardless of the mode of birth, that the infant be placed on the mother's chest (termed skin-to-skin contact), and to delay any other routine procedures for at least one to two hours or until the baby has had its first breastfeeding.

Vaginal delivery is generally recommended as a first option... A common condition that results in hearing loss is chronic ear infections. Child safety seat Child safety seats provide passive restraints and must be properly used to be effective. positioning to avoid developing positional plagiocephaly (‘flat head syndrome’). Many jurisdictions require children defined by age, weight, or height to use a government-approved child safety seat when riding in a vehicle. Most commonly these seats are purchased and installed by car owners, but car manufacturers may integrate them directly into their vehicle's design and generally are required to provide anchors and ensure seat belt compatibility. However, research indicates that many child safety restraints are often not installed or used properly. To tackle this negative trend, health officials and child safety experts produce child safety videos to teach proper car seat installation to parents and caregivers.
