Transition to Citizens: The conversation addresses how to make the climate transition tangible for the public. Professor Neuhoﬀ suggests framing climate policy as a social agenda. He proposes a \"worst-performing buildings first\" strategy, using carbon pricing revenues to fund retrofits for the least-eﬃcient homes. This approach would directly help low-income households most aﬀected by high energy costs, making the benefits of climate action personal and immediate.

Professor Neuhoﬀ argues that in order to tackle these crises we have to stay on track or even accelerate the climate transition. He explains that clean energy technologies oﬀer the lowest long-term energy costs, which is crucial for the survival and future of Germany's industrial sector.

discussion turns to energy price volatility. Professor Neuhoﬀ highlights the failures of past energy policies, which allowed producers to profit from price spikes during crises, undermining public trust. He advocates for a redesign of the energy market with instruments like \"contracts for difference,\" which would secure long-term stable prices for both consumers and businesses, protecting the economy from future shocks.

Professor Neuhoﬀ advises against worrying about a global \"leadership vacuum\" left by the U.S. and instead advocates for strong partnerships with key countries like the one of the Global South.
