Unlike the yolk, which is high in lipids (fats), egg white contains almost no fat, and carbohydrate content is less than 1%. Egg whites contain about 56% of the protein in the egg. Egg white It forms around fertilized or unfertilized egg yolks. In August 2010, the FDA ordered the recall of 380 million eggs because Egg white is the clear liquid (also called the albumen or the glair/glaire) contained within an egg. The primary natural purpose of egg white is to protect the yolk and provide additional nutrition for the growth of the embryo (when fertilized).
