== History == 87062bf9da The expression "Baixada Fluminense" has two definitions: one in the stricto sensu sense (the predominant definition of the term in this article), and another in the lato sensu sense. In the strict sense, the expression refers to the political, economic, and social region discussed above, defined by its relationship with the rest of the metropolitan area of Rio de Janeiro, especially with the metropolitan core. In this sense, the term denotes the area of direct expansion of the Rio de Janeiro metropolis beyond the administrative limits of the core municipality. Most public transport rail systems in Brazil operate on electric power supplied via overhead lines, such as the Belo Horizonte Metro and the Baixada Santista Light Rail, or through an energized third rail or APS technology, as seen with the Rio de Janeiro Light Rail. Some networks, primarily located in the Northeast, are not electric but diesel-powered, such as the Teresina Metro and the urban trains operated by CBTU in the region. 87062bf9da

The system was rated the most satisfying transportation mode in the Metropolitan Region of São Paulo, with a 79% approval rate, surpassing the long-lasting winning streak of São Paulo Metro (74% approval rate), according to the National Association for Public Transport's (Associação Nacional de Transportes Públicos) 2011 survey. 87062bf9da The seven lines in the metro system operate on 116 kilometres (72 mi) of route, serving 106 stations. It is complemented by a network of metropolitan trains, which serve the city of São Paulo and the São Paulo Metropolitan Region.
