The region was ruled later by the Cholas, as evident from temple epigraphs. It was under the control of Pandyas, Vijayanagara Empire and the Madurai Nayaks across various periods in history. In the later part of the 18th century, the region came under the Kingdom of Mysore and the British East India Company annexed it to the Madras Presidency in 1799. After Indian Independence in 1947, it became part of Madras State, the predecessor of Tamil Nadu. 355644bc9e == Overview == 355644bc9e Mayiladuthurai district is located in the fertile delta region of the Kaveri River.
