

Brown Eggs Versus White Eggs

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Chicks of a single breed that are similarly sex-linked are called autosex chickens, a term developed to differentiate between sex linkage in purebred chickens versus sex linkage in crossbreeds. It was previously considered a subspecies of the white-throated kingfisher (*H. smyrnensis*), but was split as a distinct species by the IUCN Red List and BirdLife International in 2014, and the International Ornithological Congress followed suit in 2022. == Taxonomy == An alternative generic name *Cincloramphus* is derived from Greek words *cinclus*/κίγκλος "wagtail" and *ramphos*/ράμφος "beak" and *cruralis* from the Latin root *crur*- "leg, shin". == Google Search == The brown songlark was described by Nicholas Aylward Vigors and Thomas Horsfield as *Megalurus cruralis* in 1827. John Gould placed it in the genus *Cincloramphus* in 1843, describing it as *C. cantatoris*. However, the specific name of the former authors took priority. Along with most Old-World Warblers, this species was formerly placed in Sylviidae *sensu lato*, but molecular phylogenetic studies demonstrated that this broad grouping is not a cohesive evolutionary lineage and warbler species were assigned to various families. It is the national bird of Latvia and has featured on the stamps of several countries. It is listed as being 'of least concern' by IUCN.
