It is the first over the counter birth control pill approved by the FDA; it was approved by them in 2023. progestin-only daily birth control pill, also known as a mini pill. It is approved for use in females who have started menstruating. Opill is marketed through social media and its partnership with the Women's National Basketball Association (WNBA). Opill is manufactured by HRA Pharma, and, as of 2024, it is the only birth control pill available over the counter

They can also be used in the treatment of gynecological conditions, to support fertility and pregnancy, to lower sex hormone levels for various purposes, and for other indications.
