Each pore complex in the human cell nucleus is composed of about 1,000 individual protein molecules, from an evolutionarily conserved set of 35 distinct nucleoporins. The conserved sequences that code for nucleoporins regulate molecular transport through the nuclear pore. Nucleoporin-mediated transport does not entail direct energy expenditure but instead relies on concentration... 8cab248203 The white ghost catshark has a slender and cylindrical body with a relatively long and flattened snout. It is distinguished from the other 10 North Atlantic *Apristurus* species by the following. It has a uniform whitish coloration and large oval eyes with a weak subocular fold. Its snout is bell shaped and contains numerous visible pores making up ampullae of Lorenzini on the dorsal and ventral side of the snout. Its preorbital snout length (where the snout intersects its eyes) equals half of its head length. *Aphyodes* has elliptical ampullae patterns on the ventral midline of the snout and a slender elliptical patch on the dorsal side. *Aphyodes* has a strongly arched mouth with well developed labial... 8cab248203 A deep-water catshark known from the eastern North Atlantic from depths of 1,014 to 1,800 m, it is known from only a limited number of specimens. Nuclear transport includes the transportation of RNA and ribosomal proteins from the nucleus to the cytoplasm, and the transport of proteins (such as DNA polymerase and lamins), carbohydrates, signaling molecules, and lipids into the nucleus. Each nuclear pore complex can actively mediate up to 1000 translocations per second. The nuclear pore complex (NPC) is a large protein complex giving rise to the nuclear pore. The pores enable the nuclear transport of macromolecules between the nucleoplasm of the nucleus and the cytoplasm of the cell. Small molecules can easily diffuse through the pores. Acne mechanica The term "acne" itself describes the occurrence in which hair follicles (also known as pores) in the skin get clogged by oil, dead skin cells, dirt and bacteria, or cosmetic products and create a pimple. In addition to those mechanisms, the skin not getting enough exposure to air also contributes to the formation of acne mechanica. The symptoms may vary also depending on a person's skin type; overly Acne mechanica is an acneiform eruption that has been observed after repetitive physical trauma to the skin such as rubbing, occurring from clothing (belts and straps) or sports equipment (football helmets and shoulder pads). It is often mistaken as a rash that forms on sweaty skin that is constantly being rubbed, but in reality, it is a breakout of acne mechanica. whiteheads are closed and clogged pores whereas blackheads are also clogged but open pores. Pimples can vary in type, size, and shape, but the sole basis of them occurring is the same - the oil gland in the pore becomes clogged and sometimes infected, which creates pus in order to fight the infection and subsequently causes the development of swollen, red lesions on the skin 8cab248203

Sebum is produced by sebaceous glands from the skin. Sebum has a complex composition that is different from epidermal lipids found anywhere in the human body, for example, squalene and wax esters are only found in sebum. Triglycerides and fatty acids, taken together, account for the predominant proportion (57.5%), followed by wax esters (26%) and squalene (12%). The least abundant lipid in sebum is cholesterol, which with its esters, accounts for the 4.5% of total lipids. 8cab248203

SK channel A loop between S5 and S6—called the P-loop—provides the pore-forming region that always faces the center of the channel. SK channels are a type of ion channel allowing potassium cations to cross the cell membrane and are activated (opened) by an increase in the concentration of intracellular calcium through N-type calcium channels. Their activation limits the firing frequency of action potentials and is important for regulating afterhyperpolarization in the neurons of the central nervous system as well as many other types of electrically excitable cells. This is accomplished through the hyperpolarizing leak of positively charged potassium ions along their concentration gradient into the extracellular space. This hyperpolarization causes the membrane potential to become more negative. Each of the subunits has six SK channels (small conductance calcium-activated potassium channels) are a subfamily of calcium-activated potassium channels. SK channels are thought to be involved in synaptic plasticity and therefore play important roles in learning and memory. They are so called because of their small single channel conductance in the order of 10 pS 8cab248203
