

Tehri Dam Is On Which River

The Sarda Dam was constructed in 1967 (1346 in the Islamic calendar) by engineers from the then-Soviet Union, during the reign of Mohammad Zahir Shah. The maximum capacity of its reservoir is around 260 million cubic meters of water. It provided water for irrigation purposes to more than 67,000 jeribs of agricultural land. The reservoir is fed by the Jilga River which flows north-south from Paktia and Paktika provinces. The river is also labeled as the Gardez River north of the dam and the Sarda River south of the dam (by the National Atlas of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, page 13-14). 155df79004

Koteshwar Dam The last two generators were made operational in March 2012. The project was approved in 2000, and its first generator was commissioned on 27 March 2011, and the second on 30 March 2011. The spillway was commissioned in Jan 2011. In addition, the dam has a 400 MW

== History == 155df79004 The dam is located at a gorge near the (now

submerged) upstream Bhakra village in Bilaspur district of Himachal Pradesh and is of height 226 m. The length of the dam (measured from the road above it) is 518.25 m and the width is 9.1 m. Its reservoir known as "Gobind Sagar" stores up to 9.34 billion cubic metres of water. The 90 km long reservoir created by the Bhakra Dam is spread over an area of 168.35 km². In terms of storage of water, it is the third largest reservoir in India, the first being Indira Sagar dam in Madhya Pradesh with capacity of 12.22 billion cubic meters and the second being Nagarjunasagar Dam in Telangana.

Sunderlal Bahuguna He fought for the

preservation of forests in the Himalayas, first as a member of the Chipko movement in the 1970s, and later spearheaded the anti-Tehri Dam movement from the 1980s to early 2004. The idea of the Chipko movement was suggested by his wife Vimla Bahuguna and him. despite a court case which ran in the Supreme Court for over a decade, work resumed at the Tehri Dam in 2001, after which he was arrested on 24 April 2001. He was one of the early environmentalists of India, and later he and others associated with the Chipko movement started taking up wider environmental issues, such as being opposed to large dams 155df79004
