Additionally many prostate cancers detected by screening develop so slowly that they would not cause problems during a man's lifetime, making the complications due to treatment unnecessary. Those with elevated PSA may undergo secondary screening Prostate cancer is the uncontrolled growth of cells in the prostate, a gland in the male reproductive system below the bladder. Abnormal growth of prostate tissue is usually detected through screening tests, typically blood tests that check for prostate-specific antigen (PSA) levels. urological procedures can increase PSA levels; taking 5 α -reductase inhibitors can decrease PSA levels 18f345d775

Gallium scan As they are isotopic, Both ^{67}Ga and ^{68}Ga salts have the same uptake mechanisms. Gallium is particularly useful in imaging osteomyelitis that involves the spine, and in imaging older and chronic infections that may be the cause of a fever of unknown origin. Due to lack of disease specificity, imaging with radioactive gallium(III) salts or complexes, such as ^{67}Ga citrate, has gradually become less important over time and is rarely used these days. The gallium(III) is rapidly bound by transferrin, which then preferentially accumulates in tumors, inflammation, and both acute and chronic infection, allowing these pathological processes to be imaged. The gamma emission of gallium-67 is imaged by a gamma camera, while the positron emission of gallium-68 is imaged by positron emission tomography (PET). The FDA considers A gallium scan is a type of nuclear medicine diagnostic investigation that uses either a gallium-67 (^{67}Ga) or gallium-68 (^{68}Ga) radiopharmaceutical to obtain images of a specific type of tissue, or disease state of tissue. the cancer was spreading because of rising prostate specific antigen or PSA. Diagnosis requires a biopsy of the prostate. If cancer is present, the pathologist assigns a Gleason score; a higher score represents a more dangerous tumor. Medical imaging is performed to look for cancer that has spread outside the prostate. Based on the Gleason score, PSA levels, and imaging results, a cancer case is assigned a stage 1 to 4.
