Muscle weakness is also a common symptom of vitamin D deficiency, further increasing the risk of falls and bone fractures in adults. Deficiency impairs bone mineralization, leading to bone-softening diseases, such as rickets in children. It most commonly occurs in people when they have inadequate exposure to sunlight, particularly sunlight with adequate ultraviolet B rays. It can also worsen osteomalacia and osteoporosis in adults, increasing the risk of bone fractures. pregnancies are at elevated risk of osteomalacia

Although human osteopetrosis is a heterogeneous disorder encompassing different molecular lesions and a range of clinical features, all forms share a single pathogenic nexus in the osteoclast. The exact molecular defects or location of the mutations taking place are unknown. The underlying mechanism is usually a problem with connective tissue due to a lack of, or poorly formed, type I collagen.
