Cavanilles is most famous for his 2-volume book on Spanish flora, published in 1795 and titled 'Observations on the Natural History, Geography and Agriculture of the Kingdom of Valencia'. He named many plants, particularly from Oceania. He named at least 100 genera, about 54 of which were still used in 2004, including Dahlia, Calycera, Cobaea, Galphimia, and Oleandra. The standard author abbreviation Cav. is used to indicate this person as the author when citing a botanical name. 042ae210a5 On 19 March 2020, a nationwide lockdown was established in Argentina. He lived in Paris from 1777 to 1781, where he followed careers as a clergyman and a botanist, thanks to André Thouin and Antoine Laurent de Jussieu. The bombings occurred three days before general elections, in which incumbent José María Aznar's PP was defeated.
