Dosha These qualities and functions are affected by external and internal stimuli received by the body. role in the perception of taste together with nourishment and lubrication. Beginning with twentieth-century ayurvedic literature, the "three-dosha theory" (Sanskrit: त्रिदोषा-उपादेशः, tridoṣa-upadeśaḥ) has described how the quantities and qualities of three fundamental types of substances called wind, bile, and phlegm (Sanskrit: वायु, पित्त, कफ; vāta, pitta, kapha) fluctuate in the body according to the seasons, time of day, process of digestion, and several other factors and thereby determine changing conditions of growth, aging, health, and disease. Yoga Dosha (Sanskrit: दोष, IAST: doṣa) is a central term in ayurveda originating from Sanskrit, and which refers to three categories or types of substances that are believed to be present conceptually in a person's body and mind. Kapha (synonym: śleṣman) is the normal Sanskrit word meaning "phlegm". These dosha are assigned specific qualities and functions a8a2b1f996

Brihadratha Ikshvaku This name Brihadratha of a warrior king who was a Maharatha is found in the Rig Veda. Maitri Upanishad belongs to the Maitrayaniya branch of Krishna Yajur Veda, which upanishad was taught to Sakayana by Maitri or Maitreya, the son of Mitra. unsubstantial body

which is a conglomeration of ordure, urine, wind, bile and phlegm, and which is spoiled by the content of bones, skin, sinews, marrow, flesh Brihadratha, belonging to the Ikshvaku race, was a king of the Vedic era (there are several kings of this name in Hindu tradition). Brihadratha chose the knowledge of the Self when he was offered a boon. The word, Brihadratha, means the Mighty Warrior. He gave up his home and possessions and thereafter assisted by Sakayanya even renounced the “I-ness” of his body. No other information about him or his period is available in this text or in any other text. He appears at the beginning of the Maitri Upanishad after he had renounced his kingdom in favour of his son, seeking for himself relief from the endless cycle of birth and rebirth a8a2b1f996

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
