Many IBCs are reused with proper cleaning and reconditioning or repurposed. f505732440 Many countries are introducing legislation to phase out lightweight plastic bags, because plastic never fully breaks down, causing everlasting pollution of plastics and environmental impacts. Every year, about 1 to 5 trillion plastic bags are used and discarded around the world. From point of sale to destination, plastic bags have a lifetime of 12 minutes. In 2023 alone, preliminary figures indicate that over 400 million metric tons of plastic were produced worldwide. If global trends in plastic demand continue, it is projected that annual global plastic production will exceed 1.3 billion tons by 2060. Plastic bottles were first used commercially in 1947, but remained impractical until the 1970s, when the PET bottle was introduced. They quickly became popular with manufacturers and customers because they are lighter, cheaper and easier to transport than glass bottles and less susceptible to corrosion than metal containers. However, their greatest advantage over glass bottles is their superior resistance to breakage, in both production and transportation. == Design == f505732440 In the late 1950s, Curt Lindquist, the CEO of the Celloplast company in Sweden, experimented with a new and promising material: plastic. By cutting and heat-sealing pieces together, he invented the first seamless plastic bag. The patent was awarded in 1965.
