Human head The face, except for the exposed sensory organs, is wrapped by tegument (skin, hair on the majority of the surface). detailing head sizes in infants and children exist, most do not measure average head circumference past the age of 21. It houses the brain, forming the cranial cavity for protection and support through the skull, which also forms the orbits and nasal cavity. The sensory organs and the mouth are part of the head. Macrocephaly People diagnosed with macrocephaly will receive further medical tests to determine whether the syndrome is accompanied by particular disorders. Many genetic conditions are associated with macrocephaly, including familial macrocephaly related to the holgate gene, autism, PTEN mutations such as Cowden disease, neurofibromatosis type 1, and tuberous sclerosis; overgrowth syndromes... Neck Within these compartments, the neck houses the cervical vertebrae, the cervical portion of the spinal cord, upper parts of the respiratory and digestive tracts, endocrine glands, nerves, arteries and veins. It supports the weight of the head and protects the nerves that transmit sensory and motor information between the brain and the rest of the body. to lower-body fat distribution for diseases such as type 2 diabetes mellitus or ischemic cardiopathy. Anatomically, the human neck is divided into four compartments: vertebral, visceral, and two vascular compartments. The muscles of the neck, which are separate from the compartments, form the boundaries of the neck triangles. The parents' height (the father was 170 cm tall and the mother was 153 cm tall), skin color (light), and craniofacial appearance were normal and average for their Japanese background, the mother did not have any history of miscarriage or stillbirth. Fetal macrosomia and LGA often do not present with noticeable patient symptoms. Important signs include large fundal height (uterus size) and excessive amniotic fluid (polyhydramnios). Large for gestational age Macrosomia is a similar term that describes excessive birth weight, but refers to an absolute measurement, regardless of gestational age. Large for gestational age (LGA) is a term used to describe infants that are born with an abnormally high weight, specifically in the 90th percentile or above, compared to other babies of the same developmental age. Typically the threshold for diagnosing macrosomia is a body weight between 4,000 and 4,500 grams (8 lb 13 oz and 9 lb 15 oz), or more, measured at birth, but there are difficulties reaching a universal agreement of this definition

History According to the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists, the main methods to calculate gestational age are: Structure Traditionally, clothes have been labelled using many different ad hoc size systems, which has resulted in varying sizing methods between different manufacturers made for different countries due to changing demographics and increasing rates of obesity, a phenomenon known as vanity sizing. This results in country-specific and vendor-specific labels incurring additional... Many people with abnormally large heads or large skulls are healthy, but macrocephaly may be pathological. Pathologic macrocephaly may be due to megalencephaly (enlarged brain), hydrocephalus (abnormally increased cerebrospinal fluid), cranial hyperostosis (bone overgrowth), and other conditions. Pathologic macrocephaly is called "syndromic", when it is associated with any other noteworthy condition, and "nonsyndromic" otherwise. Pathologic macrocephaly may be caused by congenital anatomic abnormalities, genetic conditions, or by environmental events. The disorder is caused by a disruption to the genetic processes that form the brain early in pregnancy, though the cause is not identified in most cases. Many genetic syndromes can result in microcephaly, including chromosomal and single-gene conditions, though almost always in combination with other symptoms. Mutations that result solely in microcephaly (primary microcephaly) exist but are less common. External toxins to the embryo, such as alcohol during pregnancy or vertically transmitted infections, can also result in microcephaly. Microcephaly serves as an important neurological indication or warning sign, but no uniformity exists in its definition. It is usually defined as a head circumference more than two standard deviations below the mean... Numerous skeletal muscles, as well as mobile articulations in the neck, grant the head mobility.

Humerus The line separating the head from The humerus (; pl. : humeri) is a long bone in the arm that runs from the shoulder to the elbow. It connects the scapula and the two bones of the lower arm, the radius and ulna, and consists of three sections. The humeral upper extremity consists of a rounded head, a narrow neck, and two short processes (tubercles, sometimes called tuberosities). As well as its true anatomical neck, the constriction below the greater and lesser tubercles of the humerus is referred to as its surgical neck due to its tendency to fracture, thus often becoming the focus of surgeons. The shaft is cylindrical in its upper portion, and more prismatic below. The lower extremity consists of 2 epicondyles, 2 processes (trochlea and capitulum), and 3 fossae (radial fossa, coronoid fossa, and olecranon fossa). its circumference, while in the upper half, it is represented by a narrow groove separating the head from the tubercles

Gestational age Such methods include adding 14 days to a known duration since fertilization (as is possible in in vitro fertilization), or by obstetric ultrasonography. The popularity of using this measure of pregnancy is largely due to convenience: menstruation is usually noticed, while there is generally no convenient way to discern when fertilization or implantation occurred. determination of gestational age is most accurate earlier in the pregnancy. Assessment of gestational age can be made based on selected head and trunk parameters In obstetrics, gestational age is a measure of the age of a pregnancy taken from the beginning of the woman's last menstrual period (LMP), or the corresponding age of the gestation as estimated by a more accurate method, if available

Microcephaly Brain development is often affected; people with this disorder often have an intellectual disability, poor motor function, poor speech, abnormal facial features, seizures and dwarfism. as a head circumference more than two standard deviations below the mean for age and sex. Microcephaly may be present at birth or it may develop in the first few years of life.
