Instead of sending signals via surface lines wrapping the globe, or bouncing them to a satellite and back, the company has hit on a way to control how neutrinos change their status, I think in the story it's their "flavor". They use a particle accelerator to produce collisions that send a stream of neutrinos in a straight line through the center of the earth and to the antipodes. Besides the accelerator, the only installation required is the detector at the other end.
