Major standards include UN/EDIFACT, ANSI ASC X12, GS1 EDI, TRADACOMS, ODETTE, and HL7. EDI is used across a wide range of industries. EDI documents can be transmitted using a variety of communication protocols, including Internet-based protocols, either directly between trading partners
