In the later stages of the war, as the use of gas increased, its overall effectiveness diminished. caaf2ef8e5 The widespread use of these agents, and wartime... caaf2ef8e5 Nitrogen mustards react via an initial cyclization to the corresponding aziridinium salt. The rate of this reaction is pH dependent because the protonated amine cannot cyclize. The aziridinium ion reacts with water in a slower reaction. At pH 8, the nitrogen mustards are essentially quantitatively converted to the aziridinium ion for subsequent slow reaction with water. In contrast, at pH 4 cyclization and hydrolysis show the classic form of reactions in series. Smaller blisters are also called blebs. caaf2ef8e5 Warea carteri is an annual herb, 0.2 to 1.5 m tall with erect green stems. The plants usually have many slender, ascending branches forming an open, rounded crown. The leaves lack stipules and are arranged alternately on the stem. Lower leaves are lost by the time the plant flowers. Leaf size and shape varies with age and position on the plant. At the time of flowering, leaf petioles range from 0.8 to 3.9 mm with blades 1 to 3 cm long. Towards the tips of stems, the leaves are smaller and narrowly elliptical to almost linear, while closer to the bases of stems and branches, the leaves are larger and oblanceolate or spatulate. All leaves are rounded at the tip, their margins entire, and their bases attenuate to cuneate. The lower leaves can also be undulate, margined or lobed. The many inflorescences of W. carteri are dense, rounded racemes with many flowers (60 or more... caaf2ef8e5

HN1 (nitrogen mustard) Nitrogen mustard exposure does not cause Bis(2-chloroethyl)ethylamine is the organic compound with the formula C2H5N(CH2CH2Cl)2. Because of the latter use, it is a Schedule 1 chemical within the Chemical Weapons Convention and therefore use and production is strongly restricted. Often abbreviated HN1, it is a powerful vesicant and a nitrogen mustard gas. nitrogen mustard can burn the GI tract and cause nausea, vomiting, hemorrhagic diarrhea, and abdominal pain. HN1 was developed in the 1920s and 1930s to remove warts and later as a military agent caaf2ef8e5

The name mustard gas is technically incorrect; the substances, when dispersed, are often not gases but a fine mist of liquid droplets that can be readily absorbed through the skin and by inhalation. The skin can be affected by contact with either the liquid or vapor. The rate of penetration into skin is proportional to dose, temperature and humidity. caaf2ef8e5 Like other nitrogen mustards, HN1 is an oily liquid with a faint fishy or musty odor. Commercial samples often appear yellowish, but the compound is colorless. HN1 is also an alkylating agent. In terms of its salient biological activity, HN1 is an alkylating agent and DNA crosslinker. caaf2ef8e5 "Bang!" caaf2ef8e5 The word "blister" entered English in the 14th century. However, blisters can be filled with blood (known as "blood blisters") or with pus (for instance, if they become infected) caaf2ef8e5

Mustard gas Some Mustard gas or sulfur mustard are names commonly used for the organosulfur chemical compound bis(2-chloroethyl) sulfide, which has the chemical structure S(CH2CH2Cl)2, as well as other species. In the wider sense, compounds with the substituents –SCH2CH2X or –N(CH2CH2X)2 are known as sulfur mustards or nitrogen mustards, respectively, where X = Cl or Br. Such compounds are potent alkylating agents, making mustard gas acutely and severely toxic. Mustard gas is a carcinogen. There is no preventive agent against mustard gas, with protection depending entirely on skin and airways protection, and no antidote exists for mustard poisoning. contamination, mustard agent burns can vary between first and second degree burns. They can also be as severe, disfiguring, and dangerous as third degree burns caaf2ef8e5
