Dental restoration Fillings may also be used to replace Dental restoration, dental fillings, or simply fillings are dentistry treatments used to restore the function, integrity, and morphology of tooth structure lost due to decay (caries), trauma, or wear. Fillings may also be used to replace or seal tooth structure around dental implants or after more

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extensive procedures such as root-canal therapy. There are two broad categories of fillings: direct restorations, placed and shaped directly inside a cleaned cavity in a single dental visit, and indirect restorations (such as inlays or onlays), which are fabricated outside the mouth (often in a laboratory) and then cemented into the tooth. Materials for direct fillings commonly include amalgam (metal) or tooth-colored composite and glass-ionomer, while indirect restorations may use ceramics, metal alloys or porcelain for greater durability and structural support. used to restore the function, integrity, and morphology of tooth structure lost due to decay (caries), trauma, or wear 2536f19bac

However, the use of braces is quite common, even when they are not medically necessary. Their cosmetic use is more common in countries with first world economies. The procedure, also known as crown-lengthening, has historically been used to treat gum disease. This method provides permanent results, while simple gum contouring may result in relapse or regrowth of the gingiva. This procedure is typically done to reduce excessively gummy smiles or to balance out an asymmetrical gum line. It is only within the past three to five years that dentists have commonly used this procedure for aesthetic purposes. This procedure involves reshaping the tissue and/or underlying bones to create the appearance of longer or symmetrical teeth, thereby making the smile more aesthetically pleasing. The practice of cosmetic gum lifts was first developed in the late 1980s, but there were few oral surgeons and dental practitioners available to perform the procedures. 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Broaching (metalworking) In both processes the cut is performed in one pass of the broach, which makes it very efficient. Linear broaches are used in a broaching machine, which is also sometimes shortened to broach. Broaching is a machining process that uses a toothed tool, called a broach, to remove material. There are two main types of broaching: linear and rotary. A rotary broach is used in a lathe or screw machine. In rotary broaching, the broach is rotated and pressed into the workpiece to cut an axisymmetric shape. In linear broaching, which is the more common process, the broach is run linearly against a surface of the workpiece to produce the cut. == History == 2536f19bac Machairodonts varied in size from comparable to lynxes to exceeding that of lions. The Machairodontinae contain many of the extinct predators commonly known as "saber-toothed cats", including those with greatly elongated upper maxillary canines, such as the famed genus Smilodon and Megantereon, though the

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degree of elongation was variable, and in some machairodontines like *Dinofelis* the length of the upper canines was much more modest. Sometimes, other carnivorous mammals with elongated teeth are also called saber-toothed cats, although they do not belong to the felids. Besides the machairodonts, other saber-toothed predators included gorgonopsians, nimravids, machaeroidines, and thylacosmilids. Unlike living big cats, which generally clamp the muzzle or throat of prey to asphyxiate them, saber-toothed machairodontines are thought to have killed prey using a bite to the neck once immobilised, using their neck muscles to drive the saber... 2536f19bac The modern sport of woodchopping is said to have had its genesis in 1870 in Ulverstone, Tasmania, as the result of a £25 (\$50) bet between two axemen as to who could first fell a tree. Dental braces Bone remodelling is a biomechanical Dental braces (also known as orthodontic braces, or simply braces) are devices used in orthodontics that align and

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straighten teeth and help position them with regard to a person's bite, while also aiming to improve dental health. Dental braces are often used in conjunction with other orthodontic appliances to help widen the palate or jaws and to otherwise assist in shaping the teeth and jaws. This is called bone remodelling. Braces can be either cosmetic or structural. They are often used to correct underbites, as well as malocclusions, overbites, open bites, gaps, deep bites, cross bites, crooked teeth, and various other flaws of the teeth and jaw. loosens the tooth after which new bone grows to support the tooth in its new position 2536f19bac

The crown can then be inserted at a subsequent dental appointment. This indirect method of tooth restoration allows use of strong restorative material requiring time-consuming fabrication under intense heat, such as casting metal or firing porcelain, that would not be possible inside the mouth. Because of its compatible thermal expansion, relatively similar cost, and cosmetic difference, some patients choose... 2536f19bac Broaches are shaped similar to a saw, except the height of the teeth increases over the length of the tool. Moreover, the broach contains... 2536f19bac Clear aligners have undergone changes, making assessment of effectiveness difficult. A 2014 systematic review concluded that published studies were of insufficient quality to determine effectiveness. Experience suggests they are effective for moderate crowding of the front teeth, but less effective than conventional braces for several other issues and are not recommended for children. In particular they are indicated for "mild to moderate crowding (1-6 mm) and mild to moderate spacing (1-6 mm)", in cases where there are no discrepancies of the jawbone. They are also indicated for patients who have

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experienced a relapse after fixed orthodontic treatment. 2536f19bac
