Naturally occurring hormones drive the cycles; the cyclical rise and fall of the follicle stimulating hormone prompts the production and growth of oocytes (immature egg cells). The hormone estrogen stimulates the uterus lining (endometrium) to thicken to accommodate an embryo should fertilization occur. The blood supply of the thickened lining provides nutrients to a successfully implanted embryo. If implantation does not occur, the lining breaks down and blood is released. It is possible to restore ovulation using appropriate medication, and ovulation is successfully restored in approximately 90% of cases. The first step is the diagnosis of anovulation. The identification of anovulation is not easy; contrary to what is commonly believed, women undergoing anovulation still have (more or less) regular periods. Combined oral contraceptive pill When taken correctly, it alters the menstrual cycle to eliminate ovulation and prevent pregnancy. females to prevent ovulation, and hence achieve contraception. It is the oral form of combined hormonal contraception. The pill contains two important hormones: a progestin (a synthetic form of the

hormone progestogen/progesterone) and estrogen (usually ethinylestradiol or 17 β estradiol). In a 28-day menstrual cycle, there are the proliferative phase, ovulation, and then the secretory phase. The combined oral contraceptive pill (COCP), often referred to as the birth control pill or colloquially as "the pill", is a type of birth control that is designed to be taken orally by women e7526ff845

Emergency contraception Mifepristone, if taken before ovulation, may prevent pregnancy. Emergency contraception (EC) is a birth control measure, used after sexual intercourse to prevent pregnancy. After ovulation, it may increase the length of the luteal phase, thus delaying menstruation by a few days e7526ff845

Menstrual cycle Menarche (the onset of the first period) usually occurs around the age of 12 years; menstrual cycles continue for about 30–45 years. These cycles are concurrent and coordinated, normally last between 21 and 35 days, with a median length of 28 days. The ovarian cycle controls the production and release of eggs and the cyclic release of estrogen and progesterone. After ovulation, the oocyte lives for 24 hours or less without fertilization. The menstrual cycle is a series of natural changes in hormone production and the structures of the uterus and ovaries of the female reproductive system that makes pregnancy possible. The dominant follicle releases an oocyte, in an event called ovulation. The uterine cycle governs the preparation and maintenance of the lining of the uterus (womb) to receive an embryo e7526ff845

Fertility testing predicting the timing of ovulation exist, some of which may be performed at home or in a clinical setting. Knowing the timing of ovulation can help a woman to plan pregnancy. Fertility testing is the process by which fertility is assessed, both generally and also to find the "fertile window" in the menstrual cycle.
