Diagnosis code Diagnostic coding is the translation of written descriptions of diseases, illnesses and injuries into codes from a particular classification. Both diagnosis and intervention codes are assigned by a health professional trained in medical classification such as a clinical coder or Health Information Manager. The adult human body is estimated to contain about 30 to 40 trillion (4×10^{13}) human cells, with the number varying between 20 and 100 trillion depending on factors such as sex, age, and weight. Additionally, there are approximately an equal number of bacterial cells. The exact count of human cells has not yet been empirically measured in its entirety and is estimated using different approaches based on smaller samples of empirical observation.
