The New York School of Abstract Expressionism was the first American style of art to have international importance. The San Francisco Bay Area was the center for an independent variant of Abstract Expressionism. The Bay Area

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Figurative Movement was in response to both. Because Bay Area Figuration often employed the spontaneity of Abstract Expressionism, it is considered a hybrid style that produced challenging or problematic pictures.

In order to succeed with imagery, writers use accompanying forms of figurative language to convey a certain message, idea, situation, setting, aesthetic, among others. That way, writers are able to get the readers to understand the ideas being conveyed without the original intent being lost.

Idiom Categorized. An idiom is a phrase or expression that largely or exclusively carries a figurative or non-literal meaning, rather than making any literal sense

Scholars group metaphors with other types of figurative language, such as

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hyperbole and metonymy. Metaphors are most similar to similes, except in metaphor the comparison is implied or assumed whereas the extra wording of a simile makes the comparison more obvious or explicit. According to Grammarly, "Figurative language examples include similes, metaphors, personification, hyperbole, allusions, and idioms." One of the most commonly cited examples of a metaphor in English literature comes from the "All the world's a stage" monologue from As You Like It: d90d9fbb0f

Metaphor other types of figurative language, such as hyperbole and metonymy. Bay Area Figurative Movement Emerging in the 1950s and 1960s, it brought together a group of artists who abandoned working in the prevailing style of Abstract Expressionism, embracing a renewed focus in figuration in painting.
