include those who have active skin conditions like cold sores, blood clotting problems, infections, scarring of the lips or certain Lip augmentation is a cosmetic procedure that modifies the shape of the lips using fillers, such as collagen or implants. The procedure may be performed to increase lip size, correct asymmetry, create protrusion, or adjust the ratio of the top and bottom lips. The procedure typically involves surgical injection, though temporary non-surgical alternatives exist

Known to Māori as tī kōuka, the tree was used as a source of food, particularly in the South Island, where it
