Spanish grammar Personal pronouns are inflected for person, number, gender (including a residual neuter), and a very reduced case system; the Spanish pronominal system represents a simplification of the ancestral Latin system. "It is this way how it must Spanish is a grammatically inflected language, which means that many words are modified ("marked") in small ways, usually at the end, according to their changing functions. Nouns follow a two-gender system and are marked for number. Verbs are marked for tense, aspect, mood, person, and number (resulting in up to fifty conjugated forms per verb). literally: "It is because of that because of which I did it"; Es así como se debe hacer = "It is this way that it must be done";, lit a3d5eac331

It can also be used as a filling in tacos, empanadas, alcapurrias, and other savory pastries or croquettes.
