Verification and validation In reality, as quality management terms, the definitions of verification and validation can Verification and validation (also abbreviated as V&V) are independent procedures that are used together for checking that a product, service, or system meets requirements and specifications and that it fulfills its intended purpose. These are critical components of a quality management system such as ISO 9000. "Independent verification and validation" can be abbreviated as "IV&V". "Independent verification and validation" can be abbreviated as "IV&V". The words "verification" and "validation" are sometimes preceded with "independent", indicating that the verification and validation is to be performed by a disinterested third party

Formal verification is a key incentive for formal specification of systems, and is at the core of formal methods. However, the PMBOK guide, a standard adopted by the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers (IEEE), defines them as follows in its 4th edition: == General ==

Informal methods of validation and verification Informal methods of validation and verification are some of the more frequently used in modeling and simulation. When executed properly, solid conclusions can be made. In some cases, informal methods offer the convenience of quick testing to see if a model can be validated. Informal methods are not less effective than formal methods and should be performed with the same discipline and structure that one would expect in "formal" methods. There are several reasons why an informal method might be chosen. While numerical results are not the primary focus, this does not mean that the numerical results are completely ignored. While many methods of validation or verification rely on numerical results, informal methods tend to rely on the opinions of experts to draw a conclusion.
