Boilie The mixture is then boiled to form hard, round balls that diffuse evenly and slowly Boilies are a type of artificial fishing bait made from boiled paste that usually consists of fishmeals, milk proteins, bird foods, semolina and soya flour, which are mixed with egg white as a binding agent. The spherical shape also allows the baits to be catapulted accurately when fishing at distant waters.
