Stay apparatus It is best known as the mechanism by which horses can enter a light sleep while still standing up. The animal can periodically shift its weight to rest a different leg, and thus all limbs are able to be individually rested, reducing overall wear and tear. The effect is that an animal can distribute its weight on three limbs while resting a fourth in a flexed, non-weight-bearing position. The relatively slim legs of certain large mammals, such as horses and cows, would be subject to dangerous levels of fatigue if not for the stay apparatus. Sleep in animals The various criteria which biologists use to define sleep states have been observed in all other animal phyla, often with profound variation in function. These genes and the gene networks they regulate give rise to the internal circadian clock. The large majority of such taxa with documented sleep physiology are bilaterians, though there is increasing evidence of sleep or sleep-like states in non-bilaterians such as Cassiopea jellyfish and hydra (both cnidarians), and sponges. Others, such as some porpoises, engage in unihemispheric sleep where only one brain hemisphere sleeps at a time in order to. In all of these taxa except sponges, regulation of sleep is documented to involve genes whose transcription oscillates with time, known as circadian or clock genes. The three categories of biological sleep schedules are diurnal, nocturnal, and crepuscular which characterize species whose waking periods mostly overlap with day, night, and twilight respectively. Scientific studies have been conducted to determine if cow tipping is theoretically possible, with varying conclusions. All agree that cows are large animals that are difficult to surprise and will generally resist attempts to be tipped. Estimates suggest a force of between 3,000 and 4,000 newtons (670 and 900 pounds-force) is needed, and that at least four and possibly as many as fourteen people would be required to achieve this. In real-life situations where cattle have to be laid on the ground, or "cast", such as for branding, hoof care or veterinary treatment, either...

Cow tipping The practice of cow tipping is generally considered an urban legend and stories of such feats are viewed as tall tales. that because cows sleep standing up, it is possible to approach them and push them over without the animals reacting. The concept of cow tipping apparently developed in the 1970s, though tales of animals that cannot rise if they fall has historical antecedents dating to the Roman Empire. The implication that rural citizens seek such entertainment due to lack of alternatives is viewed as a stereotype.
