The sympathetic nervous system is activated in cases of emergencies to mobilize. Thatching permanent houses with wooden shingles. It is a very old roofing method and has been used in both tropical and temperate climates. In most of England, thatch remained the only roofing material available to the bulk of the population in the countryside Thatching is the craft of building a roof with dry vegetation such as straw, water reed, sedge (*Cladium mariscus*), rushes, heather, or palm branches, layering the vegetation so as to shed water away from the inner roof. By contrast, in some developed countries it is the choice of some affluent people who desire a rustic look for their home, would like a more ecologically friendly roof, or who have purchased an originally thatched abode. Since the bulk of the vegetation stays dry and is densely packed—trapping air—thatching also functions as insulation. Thatch is still employed by builders in developing countries, usually with low-cost local vegetation e2be6d6dae

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
