Social security in France The Social Security is financed by payments from both employers and their employees and is administered and managed by all social partners, typically Social security (French: *sécurité sociale*, pronounced [sekyʁite sɔsjal]) is divided by the French government into five branches: illness; old age/retirement; family; work accident; and occupational disease. In addition there are numerous special regimes dating from prior to the creation of the state system in the mid-to-late 1940s. The system is divided into three main Regimes: the General Regime, the Farm Regime, and the Self-employed Regime. == History == 963d288673 Social Security is funded primarily through payroll taxes called the Federal Insurance Contributions Act (FICA) or Self Employed Contributions Act (SECA). Wage and salary earnings from covered employment, up to an amount determined by law (see tax rate table), are subject to the Social Security payroll tax. Reform proposals continue to circulate with some urgency, due to a long-term funding challenge faced by the program as the ratio of workers to beneficiaries falls, driven by the aging of the baby-boom generation, expected continuing low birth rate, and increasing life expectancy. It is primarily funded through a dedicated payroll tax. Program payouts began exceeding cash program revenues (i. e. Under more unconditional requirements, when citizenship is the sole qualification, the program becomes a universal basic income (UBI). Unlike a guaranteed minimum income, UBI does not typically take into account what a recipient already earns before receiving a UBI. A form of guaranteed minimum income that considers income as a criterion is the negative income tax (NIT).
