

What Causes Fluid Under Lungs

Pulmonary contusion As a result of damage to capillaries, blood and other fluids accumulate in the lung tissue. lung contusion, is a bruise of the lung, caused by chest trauma

The extracellular fluid, in particular the interstitial fluid, constitutes the body's internal environment that bathes all of the cells... Extracellular fluid is the internal environment of all multicellular animals, and in those animals with a blood circulatory system, a proportion of this fluid is blood plasma. Plasma and interstitial fluid are the two components that make up at least 97% of the ECF. Lymph makes up a small percentage of the interstitial fluid. The remaining small portion of the ECF includes the transcellular fluid (about 2.5%). The ECF can also be seen as having two components – plasma and lymph as a delivery system, and interstitial fluid for water and solute exchange with the cells. Treatment depends on the underlying cause. Paracetamol (acetaminophen) and ibuprofen may be used to decrease pain. Incentive spirometry may be...

Community-acquired pneumonia resulting inflammation and tissue damage causes fluid to fill the alveoli, inhibiting lung function and causing the symptoms of the disease. Common symptoms

Extracellular fluid Extracellular fluid makes up about one-third of body fluid, the remaining two-thirds is intracellular fluid within cells. Total body water in healthy adults is about 50–60% (range 45 to 75%) of total body weight; women and the obese typically have a lower percentage than lean men. The main component of the extracellular fluid is the interstitial fluid that surrounds cells. effect. Transcellular fluid is formed from In cell biology, extracellular fluid (ECF) denotes all body fluid outside the cells of any multicellular organism. This causes a slight difference in the concentration of cations and anions between the two fluid compartments

Lung The lungs are the primary organs of the respiratory system in many animals, including humans. In mammals and most other tetrapods, two lungs are located near the backbone on either side of the heart. Respiration is driven by different muscular systems in different species. In humans, the primary muscle that drives breathing is the diaphragm. Mammals, reptiles and birds use their musculoskeletal systems to support and foster breathing. Their function in the respiratory system is to extract oxygen from the atmosphere and transfer it into the bloodstream, and to release carbon dioxide from the bloodstream into the atmosphere, in a process of gas exchange. In mammals and most other tetrapods, two lungs are located The lungs are the primary organs of the respiratory system in many animals, including humans. The lungs also provide airflow that makes vocalisation including speech possible. In early tetrapods, air was driven into the lungs by the pharyngeal muscles via buccal pumping, a mechanism still seen in amphibians

Humans have two lungs, a right lung and a left lung. They are situated within the thoracic cavity of the chest. The right lung is bigger than the left, and the left lung shares space in the chest with the heart. The lungs together weigh approximately 1.3 kilograms (2.9 lb), and the right is heavier. The lungs are part of the... Pleurisy can be caused by a variety of conditions, including viral or bacterial infections, autoimmune disorders, and pulmonary embolism. The most common cause is a viral infection. Other causes include bacterial infection, pneumonia, pulmonary embolism, autoimmune disorders, lung cancer, following heart surgery, pancreatitis and asbestosis. Occasionally the cause remains unknown. The underlying mechanism involves the rubbing together of the pleurae instead of smooth gliding. Other conditions that can produce similar symptoms include pericarditis, heart attack, cholecystitis, pulmonary embolism, and pneumothorax. Diagnostic testing may include a chest X-ray, electrocardiogram (ECG), and blood
