Marine pelagic fish can be divided into coastal (inshore) fish and oceanic (offshore) fish. Siamese fighting fish Due The Siamese fighting fish (*Betta splendens*), commonly known as the Siamese fighter, or locally as the betta, is a freshwater fish native to Mainland Southeast Asia, namely Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Malaysia, Thailand, and Vietnam. It is one of more than 70 species of the genus *Betta*, but the only one eponymously called "betta", owing to its global popularity as a pet; *Betta splendens* are among the most popular aquarium fish in the world, due to their diverse and colorful morphology and relatively low maintenance. contamination can also alter the reproductive behavior of the species by decreasing hatch rate and increasing the likelihood of fathers eating their own eggs

Coral reefs occupy less than 1% of the surface area of the world oceans, but provide a home for 25% of all marine fish

species. Reef habitats are a sharp contrast to the open water habitats that make up the other 99% of the world oceans.

Most fish are cold-blooded, their body temperature varying with the surrounding water, though some large, active swimmers like the white shark and tuna can maintain a higher core temperature. Many fish can communicate acoustically with each other, such as during courtship displays. The study of fish is known as ichthyology.

The ocean's primary producers... Reef-safe fish do not consume corals or invertebrates, while fish categorized as not safe do. Fish labelled as "with caution" may have individuals within the species that could potentially eat invertebrates or cause damage to corals. There are over 33,000 extant species of fish, easily the largest group of vertebrates and more than all species of the other traditional classes, namely amphibians, reptiles, birds, and mammals, combined. Most fish belong to the class Actinopterygii... Pelagic fish range in size from small coastal forage fish, such as herrings and sardines, to large apex predator oceanic fishes, such as bluefin tuna and oceanic sharks. They are usually agile swimmers with streamlined bodies, capable

Compared to similarly sized fish, mammals and birds typically have brain sizes fifteen times larger, though some species of fish such as elephantnose fish have very large brain-to-body ratios. However, fish still display intelligence that cannot be explained through Pavlovian and operant conditioning, such as reversal learning, novel obstacle avoidance, and passing simultaneous two-choice tasks. Some fish also match mammals and birds in the executive functioning capability of inhibitory motor control.

Australian biologist Culum Brown has argued that fish may give the appearance of being less intelligent than they are due to differences between aquatic and

terrestrial... Forage fish compensate for their small size by forming schools. Some swim in synchronised grids with their mouths open so they can efficiently filter plankton. These schools can become immense shoals which move along coastlines and migrate across open oceans.

The shoals are concentrated energy resources for great marine predators. The predators keenly focus on the shoals, acutely

aware of their numbers and whereabouts, and make migrations themselves that can span thousands of miles to pursue them.

95db6e6de5 Betta fish are endemic to the central plain of Thailand, where they were first domesticated more than 1,000 years ago, among the earliest of any fish. They were initially bred for aggression and subject to gambling matches akin to cockfighting. Bettas became known outside Thailand through King Rama III (1788-1851), who is said to have given some to Theodore Cantor, a Danish physician, zoologist, and botanist. They first appeared in the West in the late 19th century, and within decades became popular as ornamental fish. *B. splendens*'s long history of selective breeding has produced a wide variety of coloration and finnage, earning it the moniker "designer fish of the aquatic..."

95db6e6de5 The marine pelagic environment is the largest aquatic habitat on Earth, occupying 1,370 million cubic kilometres (330 million cubic miles), and is the habitat for 11% of known fish species. The oceans have a mean depth of 4,000 metres (2.5 miles). About 98% of the total water volume is below 100 metres (330 ft), and 75% is below 1,000 metres (3,300 ft).

95db6e6de5 The typical ocean forage fish feed at the lower trophic level of the food chain, often by filter feeding. They include particularly fishes of the order Clupeiformes (herrings, sardines, shad, hilsa, menhaden, anchovies, and sprats), but also other small fish, including halfbeaks, silversides, smelt such as capelin and goldband fusiliers.
