Dependence arises in a dose-dependent manner and produces withdrawal symptoms that vary with the type of drug that is consumed. For example, prolonged use of an antidepressant medication is likely to cause a rather different reaction when discontinued compared to discontinuation of an opioid, such as heroin. Withdrawal symptoms from opiates include joint, bone and muscle pain, anxiety, cold sweats, increased heart rate and blood pressure, dilated pupils, vomiting, and diarrhea. Alcohol withdrawal symptoms include irritability, fatigue, shaking, sweating, and nausea. Withdrawal from nicotine can cause irritability, fatigue, insomnia, headache, and difficulty concentrating. People can become dependant on vapes. Nicotine is addictive and harmful to fetuses, children, and young people. However vaping while pregnant is less dangerous than smoking while pregnant. Health effects of electronic cigarettes Electronic cigarettes increase the risk of asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) compared to not using nicotine at all. These symptoms can include cravings for Nicotine electronic cigarettes ("e-cigs" or "vapes") can damage people's health, especially children's, but are far less harmful than smoking. Misuse, accidents, and product malfunction issues increase risks such as nicotine poisoning, contact with liquid nicotine, and severe burns. Pregnant women vaping may increase the risk of their children suffering from asthma and COPD. When nicotine intake stops, the upregulated nicotinic acetylcholine receptors induce withdrawal symptoms. Unregulated or modified e-cigs or liquids may be more dangerous than those whose production is well-regulated. Vaping is associated with heart failure, and can cause seizures. beta-endorphin

Common side effects include nausea, insomnia, abnormal dreams, headache, and nasopharyngitis (inflammation of the nose and throat). Despite these potential adverse effects, varenicline has proven efficacy in helping individuals quit smoking. It is estimated that approximately one in eleven smokers who use varenicline successfully remain abstinent from tobacco at six months. Nicotine is a parasympathomimetic stimulant that binds to and activates nicotinic acetylcholine receptors in the brain, which subsequently causes the release of dopamine and other neurotransmitters, such as norepinephrine, acetylcholine, serotonin, gamma-aminobutyric acid, glutamate and endorphins. Nicotine interferes with the blood-brain barrier function, and as a consequence raises the risk of brain edema and neuroinflammation. Another...

HTPs use embedded or external heat sources, heated sealed chambers, or product-specific customized cigarettes. Unlike e-cigarettes, which vaporize nicotine-containing liquids, HTPs typically use leaf tobacco or another solid form, though some hybrid models can use both solid tobacco and e-liquids. There are various types of HTPs. The two most common designs are battery-powered devices that heat tobacco leaf (e.g., IQOS, glo, Pax) and devices that heat tobacco using a carbon ember (e.g., Eclipse, REVO, TEEPS). Similar devices exist for heating cannabis.

Smoking cessation Tobacco smoke contains nicotine, which is addictive and can cause dependence. As a result, nicotine withdrawal often makes the process of quitting difficult. take medication. In nicotine-dependent smokers, quitting smoking can lead to nicotine withdrawal symptoms such as nicotine cravings, anxiety, irritability Smoking cessation, usually called quitting smoking or stopping smoking, is the process of discontinuing tobacco smoking

In the United States, varenicline was prescribed over 1 million times in 2020, ranking as the 275th most commonly prescribed medication. In April 2024, nicotine gum and patch products manufactured by Kenvue (marketed in many countries under the Nicorette brand) became the first nicotine replacement therapies to receive WHO prequalification, allowing their procurement through global health organizations and initiatives. A 2016 World Health Organization report found no evidence supporting claims of reduced risk or health benefits compared with conventional cigarettes. A... From 2001 to 2010, about 70% of smokers in the United States expressed a desire to quit smoking, and 50% reported having attempted to do so in the past year. Many strategies can be used for smoking cessation... Smoking is the leading cause of preventable death and a global public health concern. Tobacco use leads most commonly to diseases affecting the heart and lungs, with smoking being a major risk factor for heart attacks, strokes, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis (IPF), emphysema, and various types and subtypes of cancers (particularly lung cancer, cancers of the oropharynx, larynx, and mouth, esophageal and pancreatic cancer). Smoking cessation significantly reduces the risk of dying from smoking-related diseases. The risk of heart attack in a smoker decreases by 50% after one year of cessation. Similarly, the risk of lung cancer decreases by 50% in 10 years of cessation. Tobacco smoking was associated with appetite suppression among Pre-Columbian indigenous Americans and Old World Europeans. Tobacco companies have drawn connections between slimness and smoking in their advertisements, primarily with brands and advertisements that target women. While it is unclear how many people begin or continue smoking because of weight concerns, white female adolescents with established weight-related anxieties are particularly prone to initiate smoking. Although knowledge of nicotine's effects upon the appetite can contribute to people smoking for weight control purposes, studies have not shown that people smoke exclusively to maintain or lose weight. According to the California Department of Public Health, many people who vape do not recognize their dependence or underestimate the difficulty of quitting. The lack of clear dosage labeling on vaping products and frequent device modification can further complicate cessation efforts. Adolescents attempting to quit vaping often face challenges like exposure to peers who vape, stress from family or school, and the appeal of new e-cigarette flavors, which can lead to relapse. Heated tobacco product nicotine, and blood nicotine levels decline by

half every one to two hours. HTPs generally heat tobacco to temperatures below 600 °C (1100 °F), which is lower than the combustion temperature of conventional cigarettes. HTPs may also contain additives not naturally present in tobacco, including flavoring chemicals.
