In 2018, radar findings suggested the presence of liquid water in subglacial lakes and in 2024, seismometer data suggested the presence of liquid water deep under the surface. Even more ice might be locked away in the deep subsurface. In 2008 and 2013, ice was detected in soil samples taken by the Phoenix lander and Curiosity rover. Small amounts of water vapor are present in the atmosphere, and liquid water may be present under the surface. Pure liquid water is unstable on the surface of the planet Although very small amounts of liquid water may occur transiently on the surface of Mars, limited to traces of dissolved moisture from the atmosphere and thin films, large quantities of ice are present on and under the surface. Currently, ice is mostly present in polar permafrost. In addition, a large quantity of liquid water was likely present on the surface in the distant past. More than 5 million km³ of ice have been detected at or near the surface of Mars, enough to cover the planet to a depth of 35 meters (115 ft) 0f07ef6b6b

Chlorine played an important role in the experiments conducted by medieval alchemists, which commonly involved the heating of chloride salts like ammonium chloride (sal ammoniac) and sodium chloride (table salt), producing various chemical substances containing chlorine such as hydrogen chloride, mercury(II) chloride (corrosive sublimate), and aqua regia. However, the nature of free chlorine gas as a separate substance was only recognised around 1630 by Jan Baptist van Helmont. Carl Wilhelm Scheele wrote a description of chlorine gas in 1774, supposing it to be an oxide of a new element.
