It was developed from other types of hydraulic lime in England in the early 19th century by Joseph Aspdin, and is usually made from limestone. Routine testing of the urine with multiparameter strips is the first step in the diagnosis of a wide range of diseases. The analysis includes testing for the presence of proteins, glucose, ketones, haemoglobin, bilirubin, urobilinogen, acetone, nitrite and leucocytes as well as testing of pH and specific gravity or to test for infection by different pathogens. Iron(II) sulfate Known since ancient times as copperas and as green vitriol (vitriol is an archaic name for hydrated sulfate minerals). All the iron(II) sulfates dissolve in water to give the same aquo complex $[Fe(H_2O)_6]^{2+}$, which has octahedral molecular geometry and is paramagnetic. The hydrated form is used medically to treat or prevent iron deficiency, and also for industrial applications. Iron(II)

sulfate or ferrous sulfate (British English: sulphate instead of sulfate) denotes a range of salts of iron with the sulfate ion with the formula $\text{FeSO}_4 \cdot x\text{H}_2\text{O}$. The name copperas dates from times when the copper(II) sulfate was known as blue copperas, and iron(II) and zinc sulfate were known respectively as green and white copperas. Irish defective block crisis An expert committee established in 2016 by the then Minister of Housing and Urban Renewal investigated the causes in both County Donegal and County Mayo, and concluded that the principal cause of the damage was due to the use of defective concrete blocks. Within County Mayo the expert committee concluded that the defective blocks were caused by internal sulphate attack sourced from framboidal pyrite within the. To date the counties within the Republic of Ireland most severely impacted have been County Donegal and County Mayo, with other counties having fewer affected buildings. internal sulphate attack sourced from framboidal pyrite within the aggregate, as evidenced from both presence of framboidal pyrite and elevated sulphate content The Irish defective block crisis is an issue concerning the structural safety and potential hazards for homes constructed using concrete blocks containing excessive amounts of deleterious materials, mainly sulphide minerals and free mica. Within county Donegal this was originally termed the Mica scandal in 2011, which is the point at which homes and other buildings began showing signs of cracking and decay. The term "mica scandal" arose because the expert committee had observed that defective concrete blocks within County Donegal contained excessive quantities of the mineral mica liberated within the binder
