Services provided by enterprise software are typically business-oriented tools. As companies and other organizations have similar departments and systems, enterprise software is often available as a suite of customizable programs. Dynamic Data Driven Applications Systems Dynamic Data Driven Applications Systems (DDDAS) is a paradigm whereby the computation and instrumentation aspects of an application system are dynamically Dynamic Data Driven Applications Systems (DDDAS) is a paradigm whereby the computation and instrumentation aspects of an application system are dynamically integrated with a feedback control loop, in the sense that instrumentation data can be dynamically incorporated into the executing model of the application (in targeted parts of the phase-space of the problem to either replace parts of the computation to speed-up the modeling or to make the model more accurate for aspects of the system not well represented by the model; this can be considered as the model "learning" from such dynamic data inputs), and in reverse the executing model can control the system's instrumentation to cognizantly and adaptively acquire additional data (or search through archival data), which in-turn can improve or speedup the model (modeling process). The product was released by DEC, named the DEC SEAL by Geoff Mulligan - Secure External Access Link.
