The term "spica splint" (also known as "thumb spica splint") refers to immobilization of the lateral aspect of the thumb. There are multiple variations of the splint including short-arm thumb spica, long-arm thumb spica, and prefabricated braces. These splints can be constructed using plaster, fiberglass, or fabric. Splints can be used for definitive intervention in milder, soft-limiting injuries. They may also be used as a pre-surgical immobilization measure, post-operatively, or for temporary use following removal of a hand/thumb cast. bcbac547d1 Other less localized injuries in the shoulder, knee, and Achilles tendon have also been noted to arise from playing the Nintendo Wii. The pathophysiology is enlargement of the flexor tendon and the A1 pulley of the tendon sheath. While often referred to as a type of stenosing tenosynovitis (which implies inflammation) the pathology is mucoid degeneration. Mucoid degeneration refers to changes in fibrous tissue, such as tendon, to have less organized collagen, more abundant extracellular matrix, and changes in the cells (fibrocytes) so as to act and look more like cartilage cells (chondroid metaplasia). Diagnosis is typically based on symptoms and signs after excluding other possible causes. bcbac547d1

Spica splint removal of a hand/thumb cast. Also known as basal joint arthritis, carpometacarpal thumb OA is a degenerative condition of the thumb that causes pain, stiffness A spica splint is a type of orthopedic splint used to immobilize the thumb and/or wrist while allowing the other digits freedom to move. It is used to provide support for thumb injuries (ligament instability, sprain or muscle strain), gamekeeper's thumb, osteoarthritis, de Quervain's syndrome or fractures of the scaphoid, lunate, or first metacarpal bcbac547d1

There may be enlargement... bcbac547d1 The main symptom is pain, particularly with gripping and pinching. This pain is often described as weakness, but true weakness is not a part of this disease. People may also note a change in shape of the thumb. bcbac547d1 Wrist sprains may occur when a ligament is ruptured or lacerated in severe trauma, stretched or twisted. Commonly, wrist pain is caused by sudden load-bearing or twisting effects, such as falling from a height with an outstretched hand. football goalkeepers). The severity of the symptoms Gamekeeper's thumb (also known as skier's thumb or UCL tear) is a type of injury to the ulnar collateral ligament (UCL) of the thumb. It also occurs among people who sustain a fall onto an outstretched hand while holding a rod, frequently skiers grasping ski poles. Symptoms of gamekeeper's thumb are instability of the MCP joint of the thumb, accompanied by pain and weakness of the pinch grasp. The UCL may be merely stretched, or it may be torn from its insertion site into the proximal phalanx of the thumb bcbac547d1

Trigger digits can resolve without treatment. Treatment options that are disease modifying include steroid injections and surgery. Splinting immobilization of... bcbac547d1 The joint is formed by the trapezium bone of the wrist and the metacarpal bone of the thumb. This is one of the joints in the human body where most of us develop osteoarthritis with age. Osteoarthritis is age-related loss of the smooth surface of the bone where it moves against another bone (cartilage of the joint). In reaction to the loss of cartilage, the bones thicken at the joint surface, resulting in subchondral sclerosis. Also, bony outgrowths, called osteophytes (also known as "bone spurs"), are formed at the joint margins. bcbac547d1 The cause is usually traumatic injury. These are most commonly falls, crushing injuries, and sports injuries. Pathological fractures, from an infection or a tumour, are rarer. bcbac547d1 == Structure and etiology == bcbac547d1 Symptoms of gamekeeper's thumb are instability of the MCP joint of the thumb, accompanied by pain and weakness of the pinch grasp. De Quervain tendinopathy movement of the thumb become enlarged where they pass through their tendon sheath in the wrist. The characteristic symptoms are pain and tenderness on the thumb side of the wrist. On some occasions, there is uneven movement or triggering of the thumb and wrist with radial abduction. Radial abduction of the thumb is painful. Symptoms can come on gradually or be noted suddenly. The characteristic symptoms are pain and tenderness on the thumb De Quervain syndrome or De Quervain tendinopathy occurs when two tendons that control movement of the thumb become enlarged where they pass through their tendon sheath in the wrist. Wrist anatomy includes 20 individual ligaments attaching the eight carpal bones between the radius and ulna bones of the forearm and the metacarpal bones of the hand. Location and dynamic function of the wrist ligaments determine susceptibility to injury. Pain may be caused after exerting the wrist, as may occur during weight lifting, in any weight-bearing or athletic activity, manual labor, or from injury to nerves, muscles, ligaments, tendons or bones of the wrist. Wrist pain may result from nerve compression, tendonitis, osteoarthritis or carpal tunnel syndrome. bcbac547d1 == Signs and symptoms == bcbac547d1 The natural history of De Quervain tendinopathy (what happens without treatment) is a symptom resolution over about an approximate 1 year period. Symptom alleviation (palliative treatment) is provided mainly by splinting the thumb and wrist. Pain medications such as NSAIDs can also be considered. Steroid injections are commonly used, but are not proved to alter the natural history of the condition. Surgery to release the first dorsal component is an option. bcbac547d1 == Symptoms and signs == bcbac547d1 This intra-articular fracture is the most common type of fracture of the thumb, and is nearly always accompanied by some degree of subluxation or frank dislocation of the carpometacarpal joint. bcbac547d1

Pain stimulus It forms one part of a number of neurological assessments, including the first aid based AVPU scale and the more medically based Glasgow Coma Scale. Trigger finger be informed about the possibility of sustaining residual minor pain for up to 3 months after surgery. "Trigger Finger Trigger Thumb". The ring finger and thumb are the most common digits. There may be tenderness in the palm of the hand near the last skin crease (distal palmar crease). Treatment typically requires surgery. bcbac547d1 The pain stimulus can be applied centrally and/or peripherally, and there are benefits and drawbacks to each type of stimulus, depending on the type of patient and the response being assessed. bcbac547d1

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
