In some respects, zinc is chemically similar to magnesium: both elements exhibit only one normal oxidation state (+2), and the Zn^{2+} and Mg^{2+} ions are of similar size. Zinc is the 24th most abundant element in Earth's crust, with an average concentration of 70 grams per ton. The most common zinc ore is sphalerite (zinc blende), a zinc sulfide mineral. Zinc is refined industrially by froth flotation of the ore, roasting, and final extraction using electricity (electrowinning). It is the first element in group 12 (IIB) of the periodic table. ruthenium, iridium and others. It is a slightly brittle metal at room temperature and has a shiny blue whitish appearance when surface oxidation is removed. Zinc also has five stable isotopes; the most abundant of which, Zn-64, comprises nearly half of zinc's total abundance.
