It is edible but not widely consumed. a85c63f186 The species was first described as *Tremella auricula* by Carl Linnaeus in his 1753 *Species Plantarum* and later (1789) redescribed by Jean Baptiste François Pierre Bulliard as *Tremella auricula-judae*. In 1822, the Swedish mycologist Elias Magnus Fries accepted Bulliard's epithet and transferred the species to *Exidia* as *Exidia auricula-judae*. In so doing, Fries sanctioned the name, meaning that the species epithet "auricula-judae" takes priority over Linnaeus's earlier "auricula".... a85c63f186
