Indifference curve Utility is then a device to represent preferences rather than something from which preferences come. The main use of indifference curves is in the representation of potentially observable demand patterns for individual consumers over commodity bundles. which generates monotonically increasing utility functions, and the assumption of non-satiation (marginal utility for all goods is always positive); an upward In economics, an indifference curve connects points on a graph representing different quantities of two goods, points between which a consumer is indifferent. One can also refer to each point on the indifference curve as rendering the same level of utility (satisfaction) for the consumer. That is, any combinations of two products indicated by the curve will provide the consumer with equal levels of utility, and the consumer has no preference for one combination or bundle of goods over a different combination on the same curve. In other words, an indifference curve is the locus of various points showing different combinations of two goods providing equal utility to the consumer $44395adbea$

Ordinal utility All of the theory of consumer decision-making under conditions of certainty can be, and typically is, expressed in terms of ordinal utility. Linear utility In economics and consumer theory, a linear utility function is a function of the form: $u(x_1, x_2, \dots, x_m) = w_1 x_1 + w_2 x_2 + \dots w_m x_m$ 44395adbea

In a normative context, utility refers to a goal or objective that we wish to maximize, i.e., an objective function. This kind of utility bears a closer resemblance to the original utilitarian concept, developed by moral philosophers such as Jeremy Bentham and John Stuart Mill. 44395adbea Indifference curve analysis is a purely technological model which cannot be used to model consumer behaviour. Every point on any given indifference curve must be satisfied by the same budget (unless the consumer can be indifferent to different budgets).
