

Where Do Cloves Come From

The Escarpment was the first area of the Catskills to attract the interest of European settlers. Botanist John Bartram wrote a widely read account of an expedition there prior to independence, and a century later the North-South Lake area he had visited became home to a number of exclusive resorts, including the Catskill Mountain House. Views of it inspired Thomas Cole and other painters of the Hudson River School, the first art movement in the United States. Today much of it is New York State Forest Preserve within the Catskill Park, and a popular place for hiking, camping and other outdoor recreation.

Etymology and terminology An early recipe for orgeat can be found in The English and Australian Cookery Book: Take a pound and a quarter of bitter almonds, and half a pound of sweet almonds, which have been blanched, nine pounds of loaf sugar, six pints of water, and the rinds of three lemons. Pound the almonds in a mortar with the sugar, and add the water a little by degrees; then put the mixture on the fire with the lemon-peel. After a boil pour off the syrup and press the almonds, to extract the milk; add this to the syrup, and strain the whole through a sieve. When cold add a little orange flower water, and bottle the mixture. The orgeat is used as a summer drink, mixed with water, according to taste. Context In 1913, Handel Matschappij Liem Seeng Tee NV was established as the forerunner of Dji Sam Soe, where the name comes from the Hokkien dialect, meaning "Two Three Four". Dji Sam Soe was introduced by Liem Seeng Tee in 1913 and produced through a factory in Surabaya, East Java. In the 1990s, Dji Sam Soe developed an alternative product through machine-made kretek cigarettes... Kretek cigarettes were introduced by Haji Jamhari in the city of Kudus in 1880. Tobacco is mixed with cloves which will produce a crackling sound when burned. Cloves contain eugenol which can increase tar and nicotine levels when mixed with tobacco. Most hikers use the trail for day trips to one or two summits along the range, via the trails that go up into the cols. But backpackers have done weekend trips due to the easy availability of a state-owned campground at Devil's Tombstone, near the single road crossing at Stony Clove Notch. It is also possible for determined hikers to complete the entire trail in a single, long day.

According to Garda Maeswara (2010: 109), in 1916, Liem Seeng Tee had bought tobacco from a tobacco trader who went bankrupt. According to him, in 1940, Dji Sam Soe's sales grew rapidly with production reaching 3 million sticks, so the number of workers to roll Dji Sam Soe cigarettes was increased to 1,300 people. In many Indo-Aryan languages, chai or cha is the word for tea. This comes from the Persian چای (chay), which originated from the Chinese word for tea (茶; chá). Doodh means milk and pati means leaf. Therefore, the term, Doodh pati chai literally means milk leaf tea. Along with Round Top to the west, its distinctive ridgeline is a visual signature of the Catskills. Even today, it dominates the view of the range from the Hudson Valley. In the early 19th century, it was a frequent subject of works by Thomas Cole and other artists of the Hudson River School. Their works helped establish the Catskill Mountain House and other hotels around North-South Lake as the fashionable summer vacation spot for wealthy Americans of the era.

Dji Sam Soe Tobacco is mixed with cloves which will produce a crackling sound when burned. The brand is sold in stretched packs, two cigarettes long and ten cigarettes wide, while the sticks are rolled in white colored paper. Cloves contain eugenol which can increase tar and Dji Sam Soe (lit. city of Kudus in 1880. 'Two Three Four') is an Indonesian kretek cigarette brand launched in 1913 in Surabaya by Sampoerna

Catskill Escarpment state of New York. east, Plattekill and Kaaterskill creeks drain the two cloves that share their names, and runoff from the ridge feeds Catskill Creek and other smaller tributaries The Catskill Escarpment, often referred to locally as just the Escarpment or the Great Wall of Manitou, and known as the Catskill Front to geologists, is the range forming the northeastern corner of the Catskill Mountains in Greene and Ulster counties in the U. The plateau to the south and west averages 2,000 feet (610 m) above sea level. It rises very abruptly from the Hudson Valley to summits above 3,000 feet (910 m) in elevation, including three of the Catskill High Peaks, with almost no foothills. S b41894e2ad

Doodh pati chai Once the milk and spices come to a boil Doodh pati chai (from Hindi दूध पति चाय and Urdu دودھ پتی چائے 'milk leaf tea') is a tea beverage, originating from the Indian subcontinent, consumed in India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Afghanistan and Nepal in which milk, together with sugar, is boiled with tea. Doodh pati is different from saada chai, in that it only uses milk (as opposed to water) and tea. peppercorns, black cloves, fennel seeds, nutmeg, dried ginger powder, as well as saffron in the upper to middle classes. This tea is quite common in South Asia. It is marginally costlier than the regular, water-based saada chai b41894e2ad

Despite that popularity, the mountain was admired from afar more often than it was climbed. The road was upgraded in 1873 to the Stoney Clove Turnpike, which serviced hotels and resorts in the Catskills. In 1930, the route was designated as NY 214, but the part in Greene County was not state-maintained, instead by the county. From 1946 to 1956, the residents of the hamlet of Lanesville spent time fighting for NY 214 to be reconstructed due to being an unsafe dirt road for their children to attend school using their bus. After two sections were completed by 1952, the last section in Greene County was a political debate for four years over the New York State Department of Public Works delaying the project for a multitude of reasons. Kaaterskill High Peak lower one Round Top. It is, however, the fourth most prominent peak in the range. It was once believed to be the highest peak in the entire range, but its summit, at 3,655 feet (1,114 m) in elevation, places it only 23rd among the Catskill High Peaks. Due to its situation as the easternmost High Peak, its summit is just outside the watersheds of New York City's reservoirs in the region. The "Kaaterskill" is from the nearby creek and clove, in order to distinguish it from other "High Peaks" and "Round Tops" in the Kaaterskill High Peak (officially just High Peak) is one of the Catskill Mountains, located in the Town of Hunter in Greene County, New York, United States b41894e2ad

While the mountain is closely associated with the eponymous ski area built around the Colonel's Chair ridge at the mountain's northwest corner, that takes up only a small portion of the mountain.
