The symptoms and signs of Bright's disease were first described in 1827 by the English physician Richard Bright, after whom the disease was named. In his Reports of Medical Cases, he described 25 cases of dropsy (edema) which he attributed to kidney disease. Symptoms and signs included: inflammation of serous membranes, haemorrhages, apoplexy, convulsions, blindness and coma. Many of these cases were found to have albumin in their urine (detected by the spoon and candle-heat coagulation), and showed striking morbid changes of the kidneys post-mortem. The triad of dropsy, albumin in the urine and kidney disease came to be regarded as characteristic of Bright's disease.

Multiple types of treatment or prevention have been attempted. The use of insecticides against the beetle vectors was tried in America in the 1940s and 1950s, causing significant harm to other organisms including insects and birds. Several fungicides are effective at protecting individual trees by injection every two or three years, as long as the root system has not been infected. A vaccine, Dutch Trig, uses a different fungus, *Verticillium albo...*

Lyme disease Lyme disease, also known as Lyme borreliosis, is a tick-borne disease caused by species of *Borrelia* bacteria, transmitted by blood-feeding ticks in the genus *Ixodes*. Infections are most common in the spring and early summer. It is the most common disease spread by ticks in the Northern Hemisphere. Infection is treatable with antibiotics. Early detection and prompt treatment are associated with more favorable outcomes. For some patients, recovery may not be immediate or complete, resulting in long-term effects. Most treated patients experience a full recovery

The cause of Ménière's disease is unclear, but likely involves both genetic and environmental factors. Several theories exist for why it occurs, including constrictions in blood vessels, viral infections, and autoimmune reactions. About 10% of cases run in families. Symptoms are believed to occur as the result of increased fluid buildup in the labyrinth of the inner ear. Diagnosis is based on the symptoms and a hearing test. Other conditions that may produce similar symptoms include vestibular migraine and transient ischemic attack. Subsequent work by Bright and others indicated an association with cardiac hypertrophy, which Bright attributed to stimulation of the heart.
