Diagnosis requires a consistent pattern of emotional and physical symptoms occurring after ovulation and before menstruation to a degree that interferes with normal life. Other... caalfa5c9a Naturally occurring hormones drive the cycles; the cyclical rise and fall of the follicle stimulating hormone prompts the production and growth of oocytes (immature egg cells). The hormone estrogen stimulates the uterus lining (endometrium) to thicken to accommodate an embryo should fertilization occur. The blood supply of the thickened lining provides nutrients to a successfully implanted embryo. If implantation does not occur, the lining breaks down and blood is released. Menstrual cycle Women who experience The menstrual cycle is a series of natural changes in hormone production and the structures of the uterus and ovaries of the female reproductive system that makes pregnancy possible. These cycles are concurrent and coordinated, normally last between 21 and 35 days, with a median length of 28 days. hormonal changes called perimenopause. Eumenorrhea denotes normal, regular menstruation that lasts for around the first five days of the cycle. The ovarian cycle controls the production and release of eggs and the cyclic release of estrogen and progesterone. Menarche (the onset of the first period) usually occurs around the age of 12 years; menstrual cycles continue for about 30–45 years. The uterine cycle governs the preparation and maintenance of the lining of the uterus (womb) to receive an embryo caalfa5c9a

Premenstrual syndrome To be diagnosed as PMS, rather than a normal discomfort of the menstrual cycle, these symptoms must interfere with daily living, during two menstrual cycles of prospective recording. Symptoms vary, though commonly include one or more physical, emotional, or behavioral symptoms, that resolve with menses. Symptoms resolve around the time menstrual bleeding begins. The range of symptoms is wide, and most commonly are breast tenderness, bloating, headache, mood swings, depression, anxiety, anger, and irritability. PMS does not produce symptoms during pregnancy or following menopause. Severe symptoms Premenstrual syndrome (PMS) is a disruptive set of emotional and physical symptoms that regularly occur in the one to two weeks before the start of each menstrual period. An individual's pattern of symptoms may change over time. PMS-related symptoms are often present for about six days. (period pain during

Some research Menopause is the time when menstrual periods permanently stop, marking the end of the reproductive stage for the female human. Menopause is a natural part of aging, it can also be a result of surgery, or have another medical or non-medical source. Smoking cigarettes may result in an earlier menopause while having been pregnant may result in a later menopause. Women often notice symptoms of hormonal changes prior. Menopause before the age of 45 years is considered to be "early menopause", and ovarian failure or surgical removal of the ovaries before the age of 40 years is termed "premature ovarian insufficiency". Surgical menopause occurs as the result of a surgery that removes both ovaries. Natural menopause typically occurs between the ages of 45 and 55, although the exact timing can vary, occurring earlier or later for a variety of reasons.
