Contact improvisation Contact Improvisation emphasizes the interplay of gravity, momentum, and improvisation, fostering an experimental approach to movement that invites both professional dancers and newcomers into its global community. Originating in

Contact tracing Contacts are In public health, contact tracing is the process of identifying people who may have been exposed to an infected person ("contacts") and subsequent collection of further data to assess transmission. In cases of diseases of uncertain infectious potential, contact tracing is also sometimes performed to learn about disease characteristics, including infectiousness. In doing so, public health officials utilize contact tracing to conduct disease surveillance and prevent outbreaks. Contact tracing is not always the most efficient method of addressing infectious disease. In addition to infection control, contact tracing serves as a means to identify high-risk and medically vulnerable

populations who might be exposed to infection and facilitate appropriate medical care. close contacts: Once contacts are identified, public health workers contact them to offer counseling, screening, prophylaxis, and/or treatment. By tracing the contacts of infected individuals, testing them for infection, and isolating or treating the infected, this public health tool aims to reduce infections in the population.
