2025 Southern Brazil tornado outbreak The second violent tornado killed an additional person and cause extreme vegetation damage near Cândói. Governo do Estado do Paraná (in Brazilian Portuguese) During the afternoon through evening of November 7, 2025, a rare tornado outbreak occurred in the South Region of Brazil. The first and more impactful of these tornadoes directly impacted the municipality of Rio Bonito do Iguaçu in Paraná, resulting in 90% of structures being damaged or destroyed, killing five, and injuring 835 people. The outbreak produced many tornadoes off of a cold front associated with an extratropical cyclone, most notably two violent tornadoes that were spawned from the same supercell f9cc62d66a

2025 Rio Bonito do Iguaçu tornado Governo do Estado do Paraná (in Brazilian Portuguese) During the evening hours of November 7, 2025, a destructive and extremely large tornado devastated the municipality of Rio Bonito do Iguaçu in Paraná, Brazil, killing five people (one indirectly), injuring 835 others, and causing widespread damage. The same storm went on to produce another violent F4 tornado that struck nearby Guarapuava and Cândói, killing a sixth person. The tornado traveled 75 km (47 miles) and had a peak width of 3,250 m (3,550 yd) or 2. The tornado was rated F4 on the Fujita scale by PREVOTS,
