Dire wolf remains have been found across a broad range of habitats including plains, grasslands, and some forested mountain areas of North America and the arid savanna of South America. The sites range in elevation from sea level to 2,255 meters (7,400 ft). Dire wolf fossils have rarely been found north of 42°N latitude; there have been only five unconfirmed records above this latitude. This range restriction is thought to be due to temperature, prey, or habitat limitations imposed by proximity to the Laurentide and Cordilleran ice sheets that existed at the time.

The two subspecies are the Chinese water deer (*H. i. inermis*) and the Korean water deer (*H. i. argyropus*). The water deer is superficially more similar to a musk deer than a true deer; despite anatomical peculiarities, including a pair of prominent tusks (downward-pointing canine teeth) and its lack of antlers, it is classified as a cervid, yet its unique anatomical characteristics have caused it to be classified in its own genus (*Hydropotes*), as well as historically its own subfamily (*Hydropotinae*). However, studies of mitochondrial control region and cytochrome b DNA sequences placed it near *Capreolus* within an Old World section of the subfamily *Capreolinae*, and all later molecular analyses show that *Hydropotes* is a sister taxon of *Capreolus*. == Plot == Most animals drink water to maintain bodily hydration, although many can survive on the water gained from their food.
