The Greek term khēmeia, meaning 'cast together', may refer to the art of alloying metals, from root words χύμα (khúma, 'fluid') and χέω (khéō, 'I pour'). Alternatively, khēmia may be derived from the ancient Egyptian name of Egypt, khem, khm, khame, or khmi, meaning 'blackness', likely in reference to the rich dark soil of the Nile river valley.

IUPAC was established in 1919 as the successor of the International Congress of Applied Chemistry for the advancement of chemistry. Its members, the National Adhering Organizations, can be national chemistry societies, national academies of sciences, or just other bodies representing chemists. There are a total of fifty-four National Adhering Organizations and three Associate National Adhering Organizations. It is sometimes called the central science because it provides a foundation for understanding both basic and applied scientific disciplines at a fundamental level.
